DRDO successfully test fired Very Short Range Air Defence System 'Vashorad' off **Odisha** coast



- Research and Development Organisation- DRDO successfully test fired Very Short Range Air Defence System- 'Vashorad'/ VSHORADS from Integrated Test Chandipur off Odisha coast on 29 February 2024.
- Vashorad is a portable air defence system, indigenously designed and developed. VSHORADS is powered by a twin-barrel solid motor and will be used to neutralise low altitude aerial threats at short ranges.
- It has been indigenously developed by Research Centre Imarat (RCI) in collaboration with DRDO laboratories and other industry partners.

INS Garuda will induct MH 60R Seahawk multi-role helicopter.



This will mark a significant movement in India's defence modernisation.

- The Indian Navy will commission the Seahawks squadron as INAS 334.
- These helicopters come under a 24-aircraft Foreign Military Sales contract.
- The contract was signed with the US government in February 2020.
- So far, the Navy has inducted six of the 24 MH-60R helicopters.
- The MH 60R Seahawk multi-role helicopter is designed for anti-surface warfare, anti-submarine warfare, search and rescue, medical evacuation and vertical replenishment.
- The Sea Hawk is a twin turboshaft engine, multimission helicopter of the US Navy.

- Samudra Lakshmana Exercise, an important bilateral maritime exercise between India and Malaysia, is currently being conducted off the coast of Visakhapatnam from February 28 to March 2, 2024.

Joint military exercise "LAMITIYE-2024" to begin between India-Seychelles




- The tenth edition of the joint military exercise "LAMITIYE-2024" will be held between the Indian Army and the Seychelles Defense Force SDF from 18-27 March 2024. The Indian Army contingent left for Seychelles to participate in it.
- 'LAMITIYE' means 'friendship' in the Creole language and is a biennial training event and has been held in Seychelles since 2001. 45 personnel from the Gorkha Rifles of the Indian Army and the SDF will participate in the exercise.
- The 10-day joint exercise will include field training exercises, war discussions, lectures and demonstrations. The aim of the exercise is to enhance interoperability in sub-conventional operations in semi-urban environments under Chapter VII of the United Nations Charter on Peacekeeping Operations, the Defense Ministry said.
- This exercise will enhance cooperation between the two sides during peacekeeping operations.
 This exercise will also build and promote bilateral military relations in addition to the exchange of skills, experience and good practices between the two armies.
- Earlier, Indian ship INS Tir participated in Exercise Cutlass Express - 24 (CE- 24) held at Port Victoria, Seychelles from 26 February to 08 March 24 between India, the US and African countries.

- The Indian Navy has established its new base "INS Jatayu" in Minicoy Island of Lakshadweep with the aim of enhancing its operational capabilities in the Indian Ocean region.
- Earlier, the Navy had established INS 'Dweeparakshak' in Kavaratti, Lakshadweep.
- Navy Chief Admiral R Hari Kumar inaugurated the second naval base in Lakshadweep.

- The Indian Navy is a balanced and well-equipped three-dimensional force capable of operating above, on and below the surface of the ocean and is efficiently protecting our national interests.

Joint exercise 'Bharat-Shakti' of the three forces of India will be organized in Jaisalmer





- The joint exercise 'Bharat-Shakti' of the three armies of India (Army, Navy and Air Force) will be organized at Asia's largest field firing range located in Jaisalmer, Rajasthan.
- Top officials of all three armies including Chief of Defense Staff General Anil Chauhan will take part in the Bharat-Shakti exercise to be held on March 12.
 - All three armies will participate in the biggest war exercise 'Bharat-Shakti'



- All three armies of India are going to conduct the biggest 'Bharat-Shakti' war exercise at Asia's largest field firing range located in Jaisalmer district of Rajasthan.
- Bharat Shakti, starting from March 12, is a major tri-service exercise, in which the Army, Air Force and Navy will demonstrate the capabilities of weapons manufactured in the country.
- Only indigenously developed weapon platforms and systems will be included in the Bharat-Shakti war exercise. Top officials of the three forces, including Chief of Defence Staff General Anil Chauhan, will participate in this exercise.
 - CCS approves ₹15,000 crore 5th generation aircraft project

- The Cabinet Committee on Security (CCS) has approved the project for design and development of India's fifth generation fighter jet, the Advanced Medium Combat Aircraft (AMCA), to be carried out by the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO).
- The AMCA is envisaged as a 25-tonne twin-engine stealth aircraft with an internal weapon bay and diverterless supersonic intake developed for the first time in India.
- It is intended to transport 5,500 kg of external payload with internal carriage of 1,500 kg of payload and 6,500 kg of internal fuel.

INS TIRR participates in exercise cutlass express at seychelles



- INS Tir, the lead ship of the First Training Squadron (1TS), participated in Exercise Cutlass Express 24 (CE-24) held at Port Victoria, Seychelles.
- The exercise was inaugurated by Seychelles President Wavel Ramkalawan, dignitaries from India, USA and African countries were present on the occasion.
- As part of Exercise Cutlass Express, Indian Navy actively engaged with participants from 16 friendly foreign countries.

Exercise 'Tiger Triumph-24' being conducted between India and USA



- Exercise 'Tiger Triumph 24' being conducted between India and USA. 'Tiger Triumph – 24' is being conducted on the eastern seaboard from 18 to 31 March.
- 'Tiger Triumph 24' is in line with the established partnership between India and the US. It is a bilateral tri-service Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) military exercise between the two countries.
- Indian Navy ships with integral helicopters and landing craft, Indian Navy aircraft, Indian Army personnel and vehicles and Indian Air Force aircraft and helicopters as well as Rapid Action Medical Team (RAMT) will participate in this military exercise.
- The US is being represented by US Navy ships. It will include US Marine Corps and US Army soldiers.

Indian Navy conducted 'Operation Sankalp' in the Indian Ocean Region



 The Indian Navy conducted maritime security operations 'Operation Sankalp' in the Indian Ocean Region from 23 December 2023 to 23

- March 2024, the Indian Navy has completed 100 days under this mission.
- Indian Navy played a vital role as first responder and as a key preferred security partner under maritime operations in the Indian Ocean Region. CLA
- Indian Navy responded to 18 incidents during this period and played the role of first responder.
 Indian Navy conducted maritime security operations in three areas Gulf of Aden and surrounding areas, Arabian Sea and East of Somalia.
- For the last 100 days, naval ships, aircraft and special forces went on display and pledged to 'secure the seas'.

Notification issued by Department of Defence Production for restructuring DGQA



- To achieve a major reform towards 'Ease of Doing Business' and self-reliance in the defence sector, a notification has been issued by the Department of Defence Production under the Ministry of Defence for restructuring the Directorate General of Quality Assurance (DGQA).
- It aims to increase the speed of quality assurance processes and testing and reduce unnecessary delays at various levels of decision making.
- This restructuring also led to changes in the quality assurance methodology following corporatisation of OFB and a revised role of the Directorate General of Quality Assurance.
- The changes have been brought about by the inclusion of ordnance factories in new DPSUs and



the government's push towards indigenisation with the increased participation of the private defence industry.

- Hence, a need was felt to restructure DGQA to provide effective and efficient support to the emerging defence manufacturing industry.
 - The Indian Air Force (IAF) will conduct
 Gagan Shakti-2024 exercise from April 110.



- The exercise will involve all air force bases and assets across the country.
- The exercise was last conducted in 2018. It sought to test the IAF's preparedness for a two-front war with China and Pakistan.
- Gagan Shakti-2024 follows the Vayu Shakti-2024 exercise. Vayu Shakti-2024 was followed by the tri-services Bharat Shakti exercise.
- 12 air forces from across the world are likely to participate in the exercise that will be hosted by the IAF later this year.

LCA Tejas Mk-1A completes its maiden flight in Bengaluru



 On March 29, the first Tejas Mk-1A aircraft took its maiden flight from the Hindustan Aeronautics

- Limited (HAL) facility in Bengaluru, and the country can expect its early induction into the Indian Air Force (IAF).
- Following the contract secured in February 2021, HAL achieved this significant production milestone with concurrent design and development amid major supply chain challenges in a global geopolitical environment.
- HAL Chief Test Pilot Group Captain KK Venugopal (Retd) flew the Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Mk-1A for 18 minutes.
- Tejas Mk-1A will have advanced electronic radar, improved combat capabilities and better maintenance facilities.



Rajasthan gets SC nod for two-child rule for government jobs



- The Supreme Court has upheld the Rajasthan government's two-child eligibility criterion for getting public employment and ruled that it is not discriminatory and does not violate the Constitution.
- The Rajasthan Various Services (Amendment)
 Rules, 2001 bar candidates who have more than
 two children from getting government jobs. The
 apex court dismissed the appeal filed by Ramji Lal
 Jat.

New species of sea slug found in Odisha, named after President Murmu





- New sea slug, Melanochlamys draupadi, named after President Draupadi Murmu; It has a distinctive brownish-black colour with ruby red spots, measuring up to 7 mm in length.
- Discovered off the Odisha and Bengal coasts by the Zoological Survey of India.
- The research, led by Prasad Chandra Tudu of ZSI, details the morphological, physiological and molecular characters of the slug, published in Molluscan Research.

Goa became the first state in India to receive World Bank Climate Fund





- World Bank's India Climate and the Development Partners Meet was organized in Goa's capital Paraji
- During this, the Goa government and Power Finance Corporation signed an agreement with the World Bank for climate action. The objective is to reduce carbon emissions and promote climatefriendly development

Citizenship Amendment Act implemented in the country: Notification issued



- The central government has issued a notification of the Citizenship Amendment Act i.e. CAA.

- CAA is called Citizenship Amendment Act in Hindi.
- This has cleared the way for non-Muslim refugees from Pakistan, Bangladesh and Afghanistan to get citizenship.

1. Who will get citizenship:

- People of Hindu, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain, Parsi and Christian communities who came to India from Pakistan, Afghanistan, Bangladesh before 31 December 2014 after being persecuted on religious grounds will be given citizenship.
- Only people from these three countries will be able to apply for citizenship.

2. What will be the impact on Indian citizens:

US President announces ban on sale of petrol-powered cars from 2035



- US President Joe Biden has announced the toughest ever regulation on vehicle exhaust emissions in the US to accelerate the autoindustry's shift to electric cars.
- The US is taking a more lenient stance than the EU and the UK, which will ban all sales of petrolpowered cars from 2035.
- This includes a target for 56% of all new US vehicles sold to be electric by 2032 - a massive increase from current levels.
- According to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the new regulation will prevent 7 billion tonnes of carbon dioxide emissions over the next 30 years.

3rd edition of North East Games 2024 begins in Nagaland





- In Nagaland, the 3rd edition of North East Games 2024 began with a grand opening ceremony at the Regional Centre for Sporting Excellence, Sovima.
- Nagaland Chief Minister Neiphiu Rio officially declared the 3rd North East Games 2024 open.
- Over 3000 athletes from eight northeastern states are competing in 15 disciplines held at 12 venues in three districts Chumoukedima, Dimapur and Kohima.
- The main attractions of the event include archery, athletics, badminton basketball, boxing, football, lawn tennis, pencak silat, s, table tennis, taekwondo, volleyball and wushu.

UNESCO adds 18 sites to Global Geoparks Network



- UNESCO's Executive Board has decided to add 18 sites to the Global Geoparks Network.
- The total number of geoparks reached 213 in 48 countries.

- The new geoparks are located in Brazil, China, Croatia, Denmark, Finland, France, Greece, Hungary, Poland, Portugal and Spain.
- Geoparks serve local communities by combining the conservation of their important geological heritage with public access and a sustainable approach to development.
- The UNESCO Global Geopark designation was created in 2015. It recognizes geological heritage of international significance.
- Two UNESCO member countries are joining the network for the first time: New Zealand and the Philippines.

World's first Om-shaped temple inaugurated in Pali, Rajasthan



- The world's first Om-shaped temple was inaugurated at Jadan village in Pali district of Rajasthan. This temple became the first temple in the world to be designed in this iconic form.
- This architectural masterpiece will not only attract tourists but also boast of an impressive visual presence that will be visible even from space.
- The 'Om shaped' temple is spread across a vast expanse of 250 acres in Jadan village.
- This temple is shaped like the Om symbol and follows the Nagara style commonly seen in North India. It has an elaborate layout that covers an area of about half a kilometre.
- This intricate design pays tribute to the rich cultural and architectural heritage of the region.
- A remarkable aspect of this temple is that it can house 1,008 idols of Lord Mahadev and 12 Jyotirlingas within its sacred boundaries.



France is set to become the first country to pass a bill to tackle child discrimination.



- The lower house of the French Parliament has passed a bill that will ban discrimination on the basis of hair texture, length, colour or style.
- The bill will amend existing anti-discrimination measures in the labour code.
- The bill will support black people who face discrimination in the workplace because of their hair.
- Olivier Serva, a black MP from the French Caribbean island of Guadeloupe, has drafted the bill.
- The bill has been approved by 44 legislators, while two have voted against it. It will become a law after the approval of the Senate.
- 23 states in the United States have passed laws to protect people from hair discrimination in the workplace and public schools.



Russian space agency Roscosmos launches Iran's imaging satellite 'Pars-1' into space



- Russian space agency Roscosmos successfully launched Iran's imaging satellite 'Pars-1' into space from Moscow's Vostochny spaceport on a Soyuz carrier rocket. Along with this, a Russian weather satellite and 17 small satellites were also sent.
- Meanwhile, Russia's Meteor-M No. 2-4 satellite (also known as Meteor-M2-4), the sixth spacecraft in the Meteor-M series launched in 2009, was also launched, it is designed to explore the Earth's natural resources, monitor global weather.

Britain has tested a laser weapon that can strike a coin from a kilometer away



- The UK Ministry of Defense (MoD) has successfully tested its first laser weapon named "Dragonfire".
- The high-powered laser is designed to target and neutralise drones, offering a potentially low-cost alternative to conventional missiles.
- The Dragonfire laser weapon is expected to significantly reduce reliance on expensive ammunition, offering a cost-effective solution to air defence.

Scientists have discovered a 'giant' volcano on Mars.





- This massive volcano named 'Noctis Volcano' stands at a height of 29,600 feet and stretches about 450 kilometres in width.
- The location of the volcano is just south of the Martian equator, in eastern Noctis Labyrinthus, west of Valles Marineris, the planet's vast canyon system.
- Data from several missions including NASA's Mariner 9, Viking Orbiter 1 and 2, Mars Global Surveyor, Mars Odyssey and Mars Reconnaissance Orbiter have been used to make this discovery. ESA's European Space Agency's Mars Express mission was also a part of this effort.


ISRO successfully tested the landing mission of Reusable Launch Vehicle



- Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) on Friday (March 22) successfully landed the Reusable Launch Vehicle (RLV LEX-02). This indigenous space shuttle has been named Pushpak.
- It was taken to a height of 4.5 km by helicopter at the Aeronautical Test Range in Chitradurga, Karnataka and left for autonomous landing on the runway.
- ISRO posted on social media platform X and informed that Pushpak's successful landing took place at 7:10 am.
- Earlier, RLV landing experiments have been done in 2016 and 2023. This time's Pushpak aircraft is about 1.6 times larger than the last RLV-TD.
- Pushpak aircraft can bear more weight than RLV-TD. ISRO says that with this technology, rocket launches will now be cheaper than before. Now

the cost of delivering equipment to space will be much less.

China launches satellite for atmospheric, space environment monitoring



- China added to its fleet of stealth meteorological satellites with the launch of Yunhai-3 (02).
- China successfully launched a satellite for environmental monitoring from the Taiyuan Satellite Launch Center in North China's Shanxi province.
- It will be used for tasks such as detecting atmospheric and marine environment, monitoring space environment, disaster prevention and mitigation.

China launches 'Queqiao-2' relay satellite to support lunar missions



- China launched its Queqiao-2 relay satellite with a Long March 8 rocket to support upcoming lunar far side and south polar missions.
- Queqiao-2 was installed in its predetermined orbit with a perigee of 200 km and an apogee of 420,000 km.



- The 1,200-kg satellite carries a 4.2-metre parabolic antenna and is part of China's plans for future lunar exploration and a step towards building a lunar base in the 2030s.
- After reaching the moon, the spacecraft will enter a highly elliptical lunar orbit inclined 55 degrees.
- It is specifically designed to support China's Chang'e-6 lunar far side sample return mission scheduled to launch in May.
- The spacecraft will later alter its orbital period to better support the Chang'e-7 and Chang'e-8 missions to the moon's south pole later in the decade.
- The far side of the moon never faces Earth, as the planet's gravity has slowed the moon's rotation over time.

ISRO will launch START 2024 programme in April-May.



- Space Science and Technology Awareness Training (START)-2024 will be launched by ISRO.
- ISRO has invited expressions of interest for the START-2024 programme from academic institutions/universities/colleges in India.
- The START-2024 programme will be conducted during April-May, 2024.
- 'START' is an introductory level online training in Space Science and Technology for UG and PG students.
- Postgraduate students and final year undergraduate students of Physical Sciences (Physics and Chemistry) and Technology are eligible for this training.
- Educational institutions who wish to be a part of this initiative of ISRO must apply by April 2, 2024.



- MIRVs have been developed by the US, UK, Russia, France and China.
- The weapon system was tested within a range of 3,550 km.

 he International Astronomical Union (IAU) has recently recognised ISRO's Chandrayaan-3 landing site as 'Shiva Shakti' point. PM Modi had named the Chandrayaan-3 landing site as 'Shiva Shakti' on August 26, 2023.



- It is worth noting that Chandrayaan-3's Vikram lander landed on the South Pole of the Moon on 23 August 2023.
- India became the first country to soft land on the South Pole of the Moon.




- The Dandi March or Salt Satyagraha was an act of non-violent civil disobedience in colonial India led by Mahatma Gandhi.



- The holiest week of the Christian year includes the story of Jesus' crucifixion on Good Friday and their belief in the recurrence of death and resurrection on Easter.


Hola Mohalla Festival




GDP figures better than expected, strong growth of 8.4% in third quarter



- According to data released by the National Statistical Office (NSO), India's gross domestic product (GDP) recorded a strong growth of 8.4 percent year-on-year during the third quarter (October-December).
- It was 8.1 percent in the previous quarter.
- The latest GDP figures are better than analysts' expectations.
- GDP figures for the first and second quarters of the current fiscal year have also been revised upwards to 8.2 per cent (from 7.8 per cent) and 8.1 per cent (from 7.6 per cent), respectively.
- GDP forecast for fiscal year 2024 has also been revised upwards to 7.6 per cent from 7 per cent.

Moody's raises India's 2024 GDP forecast to 6.8%





- Global rating agency Moody's has raised India's GDP growth forecast for 2024 to 6.8 per cent from 6.1 per cent.
- The increase in forecast was attributed to India's strong economic performance in 2023 and easing global economic challenges.
- India's economy grew at 8.4 per cent during the October-December quarter, surpassing analysts' expectation of 6.6 per cent.
- Moody's attributed this strong growth to the government's capital expenditure and vigorous manufacturing activity.
- GDP growth for 2025 is projected at 6.4 percent.

India's WPI inflation falls to four-month low of 0.20 percent in February



- Data released by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry showed that India's wholesale price inflation fell to a four-month low of 0.20 percent in February on an annual basis, from 0.27 percent in January.
- The sequential WPI rate for February rose by 0.07 percent as against a contraction of (-)0.33 percent in the previous month.
- Food inflation stood at 6.95 percent in February.
 For the primary articles segment, the inflation rate in February rose to 4.49 percent from 3.84 percent in the previous month.

Admiral Laxminarayan Ramdas passed away at the age of 91





Former Pakistan captain Saeed Ahmed dies



- Former Pakistan Test captain Saeed Ahmed died in Lahore at the age of 86.
- Ahmed played 41 Test matches, scoring 2,991 runs with five centuries and 16 half-centuries. He also took 22 wickets with his off-spin bowling.
- Ahmed made his Test debut against the West Indies during the famous drawn Bridgetown Test in 1958 when he was 20 and played his last Test for Pakistan against Australia in Melbourne during the 1972-73 tour.



Delhi is the capital with the most polluted air in the world



- India was the third most polluted air country in 2023.
- According to the World Air Quality Report 2023 by Swiss organization IQ Air, Bangladesh was the country with the most polluted air in the world.
- Pakistan is at number two in this list of 134 countries.
- 96% people in India are breathing 7 times worse air
- According to the report, 1.33 billion i.e. 96% people in India live in such air, in which the level of PM 2.5 is 7 times more than the annual standard of WHO.
- At the same time, the annual PM 2.5 level in 66% of the cities of the country was more than 35 micrograms per cubic meter.
